The 16th Annual Put-in-Bay Chamber 5-Iron Golf Classic sponsored by E-Z-GO will be held from 9 a.m. through 6 p.m., Sunday, June 20, 2010 at Saunders Resort Golf Course, located across from South Bass Island State Park.

This annual Chamber fund raiser is a scramble tournament played by a team of four. Entry fee is \$120 per team. No teams will be accepted that have more or less than four participants. Each team may play the course once for competition. Scores from any additional rounds will not be eligible for competition for any prizes nor the championship title.

Teams will only be allowed to use a Five-Iron and a Putter to play the course. The team with the lowest score wins the Tournament. In the event of a tie, there will be a sudden death (by the hole) play-off between the teams posting the lowest score within 10 days of the tournament. In the event one or both teams are unable to field their original four players for the sudden death play off, the winner will be determined by a flip of a coin.

Eligible participants will compete for nine prize packages at each of the nine holes.

The team that wins the tournament will receive four golf shirts embroidered with the tournament logo and "2010 Champs." Championship shirts will be sent to the team captain within four weeks after a winner is declared.

Entry fee includes greens fees for nine holes of golf, a picnic lunch, water, pop and beer, players kit and a chance to win five different "hole-in-one" prizes, including \$10,000, a new E-Z-GO Golf Cart, golf clubs, a Bose stereo and a Visa gift card and some excellent prize packages at each of the nine holes, including golf bags, golf balls, clothing and many other nice prizes.

Each team must choose a captain. The team captain is responsible for registering the full names of each team member and his or her shirt size (should they win), providing a telephone number, signing a release acknowledging the team is fully aware of the Tournament Rules and signing the team's score card at the conclusion of play.

Upon registering, please select an approximate tee time. Entry fee must be paid prior to playing. No refunds will be issued. Please make checks payable to: The Put-in-Bay Chamber 5-Iron Classic.

Please note: The tournament will be held regardless of weather.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. A team is made up of four individual players. A group of less or more than four individuals will not be accepted as a team for entry in the tournament. All individual players are expected to observe course etiquette. Team members are responsible for their behavior on the course. Players who litter, damage the greens, interfere with the play of other competitors or exhibit other bad behavior may have their team disqualified from play and may be asked to leave the golf course. There are no refunds.
2. Each team must choose a captain. The captain is responsible for signing a release stating his team is fully aware of the Tournament Rules. The captain is also responsible for registering the team and providing team members' full names and golf shirt sizes. The captain must also provide a telephone number and is responsible for signing the team's score card after their round is completed.
3. The entry fee is \$120 per team. The total entry fee must be paid before play takes place. Checks should be made payable to *Put-in-Bay Chamber 5-Iron Classic*. The team must check in at Tournament Registration at the course before playing.
4. Each team may play the course once for competition in the tournament. Any additional rounds of play will not be eligible for any prize nor for the tournament title and will be assessed a greens fee to be determined by the Tournament Director. Additional rounds may be played only at the discretion of the Tournament Director with a determination of course availability.
5. In the course of play, each player will hit the ball from the tee. The team will then determine the best shot. Each team member will then hit or putt his or her ball from the same lie until reaching the cup at each hole.
6. On holes where prizes are given for the player who lands closest to the pin, only the player's drive from the tee is eligible.
7. In the Hole-in-One competitions for the E-Z-GO golf cart, the \$10,000 in cash and the set of golf clubs, each eligible participant will receive one attempt at making a hole in one. Only registered tournament players are eligible for the Hole-in-One competition. In order to claim the \$10,000 prize, a witness provided by the Tournament Director must see the hole-in-one.
8. In the event of a tie, the teams with the lowest score will compete in a sudden death play-off. Beginning at the First Hole, each tying team will compete for the lowest score at each hole. The first team to record the lowest score at a hole of play shall be declared the winner. The sudden death must be played within

10 days of the original tournament. In the event one or both teams cannot field their original four players to participate in the play-off within 10 days of the tournament, the winner shall be declared by flip of a coin.

9. Prizes for each of the nine-hole individual contests of Closest to the Pin and Longest Putt will be awarded after a Tournament Champion has been declared. Players who have a chance to win one of the prizes should leave their name, address and telephone number with the Tournament Director so they can be notified immediately if they are a winner. Please note that all prize claims are the responsibility of the winner. Large prizes such as the golf cart, sets of clubs, golf bags and any cash prizes will be the responsibility of the winner to pick up after the event or at the chamber office at the Depot within two (2) weeks. Prizes will be given only to the winner. Championship Golf Shirts will be delivered on the island or shipped on the mainland to the captain of the winning team within four weeks after a winner is declared.

11. The Chamber will not be responsible for unclaimed prizes or the inability to contact a winner who has not provided necessary information. Any prizes not claimed by the end of July 2008 will be used for future tournaments.
